Join us in Germany and reside in a majestic castle not far from Cologne, Dusseldorf, and Bonn.

Schloss Heessen in Hamm, North Rhine-Westphalia, will host Academic Camp Germany. You can enjoy the school's beautiful grounds while living in dorm rooms inside the historical castle, which even has its own island next to the Lippe river.

Subjects can be studied in German, with the option of some English lessons.

This program is ideal if you plan to study in Germany or stay in the EU for the summer on an academic program. Students who want to study at German universities will have the opportunity to learn more about it during the course.

CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning)

CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning) is the foundation of our teaching methodology. You study academic subject content while also improving your German language skills. You will broaden your academic knowledge, improve your essay writing skills, and sharpen your higher-order thinking abilities (critical, logical, reflective, metacognitive and creative thinking).







Explorers – 12 to 14 years old

We give you a taste of what awaits you in the German education system in Grade 9 and 10. You will learn German, math, science, social studies, and art.





Engagers – 15 to 17 years old

This program provides four study blocks per week and is designed for students in Grade 11, 12 and 13 in the German school system. You can select your subjects, and we will create an individual timetable based on your selections.

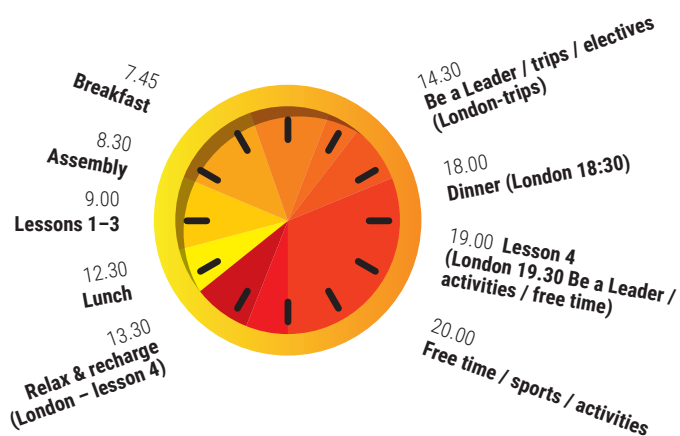

Leisure and welfare

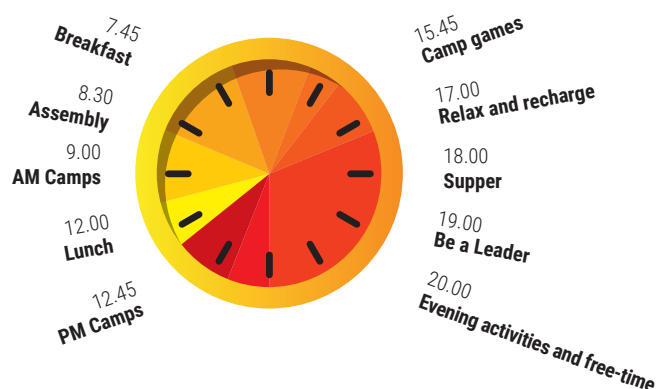
